REMARKS:

Repairs have **NOT** been made to shelter foundation since previous unsatisfactory inspections.

Previous deficiencies have **NOT** been corrected. Shelter base continues to be unstable and is a critical issue.

Shelter appears to be located in a flood prone area and **MUST** be relocated, removed, or reinforced prior to next inspection.

Dogs must **NOT** be housed in shelter until further action is taken to correct the deficiencies as discussed.

The Town of Petersburg **MUST** repair the foundation on which the shelter is currently on **OR** contract for shelter services elsewhere within the next 30 days prior to the next inspection.

Article 7 § 114 states that:

1. Each town and city, and each village in which licenses are issued shall, and any other village and any county may, establish and maintain a pound or shelter for dogs.
2. In lieu of or in addition to establishing and maintaining such pound or shelter, any town or city, or any village in which licenses are issued shall, and any other village and any county may, contract for pound or shelter services with any other municipality or with any incorporated humane society or similar incorporated dog protective association, or shall establish and maintain, jointly or with one or more other municipalities, a pound or shelter.
