Shelter is not structurally sound: At least two individual kennels have fencing that is rusted through. This causes a threat to the health and safety of the dogs housed in the kennels. There are sharps edges where the fencing is broken. These kennels cannot be used to housed dogs until repaired.

Repairs are not done when necessary: At least three kennels have chunks of mortar missing between the cinder blocks that make up the walls of the kennels. The floor drains in every kennel are completely rusted. The guillotine doors in every kennel have rust on them.
