The shelter is in good condition. The guillotine doors in the kennels are made of wood and have been chewed up on the bottoms leaving sharp edges. It is recommended that they be replaced with stainless steel or "Johnson dog doors" that can be ordered through pet supply companies. There are wooden pallets on the floor of each kennel. These keeps the dogs up off of the concrete, but are not easily cleaned and disinfected. It is recommended that ones made of fiberglass be used instead. These can also be ordered through pet supply companies.
