Ventilation is inadequate in former office rooms now used for housing dogs-very strong urine/ammonia odor present at time of inspection.

Advised that DCO's must have access to indoor shelter for un-acclimated dogs during inclement weather or be able to contact shelter staff for such access when facility is closed.
