### A. Standards of Care

Food storage area cannot be properly cleaned. Bags of food are stored directly on garage floor.

3. Repairs are done when necessary

New kennel section, end run by window had exposed insulation and on the opposite side of the window a loose wall panel about to fall into run. Main kennel has approximately nine run doors that need replacing. Some are patched some are not; all have loose wire with sharp edges that could injure dogs. The outdoor runs have one end run on the West side that has loose or broken wire and rusted through pipes that the wire/door is attached to that need replacing.

Feces and food remain in drainage area at the rear of the indoor runs in the main kennel area.
