REMARKS:

Per the Shelter Director and the Shelter Manager, this shelter facility is scheduled to discontinue providing both DCO and Shelter Services effective 01/01/2023, unless an alternate agreement is reached between the Shelter Director, the Shelter Manager and one or more of the currently contracted municipalities before this date. All affected municipalities were provided with at least two months written notice of the changes.

Only Article 7 dogs are currently being admitted and no more will be accepted past 12/31/2022. The shelter staff will continue to care for all of the animals already at the shelter on 12/31/2022 until they are able to be redeemed, transferred, adopted or euthanized per Article 7.

The Shelter Director and Shelter Manager have been advised to notify the inspector if the current circumstances change and that all required Article 7 records should be retained for at least three years.
