Blacktop base under the kennels has heaved up in some places and sunken in others, tilting the kennel panels and creating gaps under and between them. The gaps are large enough to entrap a dog's head or leg or allow escape. Shelter manager has attempted to prop up the kennels and block some of the gaps with rocks and boards. Left edge of blacktop has sunken to the point that the pipe gutter on that side is no longer functional as there is a gap and a 2-3 inch lip that prevent water from reaching it. Tilting has also strained & loosened the brackets holding panels together.

Recommend re-surfacing of base to re-level kennels and eliminate tilting, gaps and lip on drain pipe. It would likely also prolong the life of the kennel panels and increase the effectiveness of cleaning & sanitation.

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Recommend safety caging around all light bulbs within dog housing areas.
