The application and required uploads can be used to apply for funds from the Environmental Protection Fund (EPF).

All applicable materials must be submitted through the NYS Grants Gateway by the deadline, March 31, 2015, for the application to be considered complete.

The project application contains a blank for filling in the Project ID #. Enclosed is a list of Districts in the State in alphabetical order. Assigned to each District is the first part of the Project ID # (1-58). You can complete the remainder of the ID # on the application form by placing the priority number of each project you submit after the Project ID # which appears on the enclosed sheet. For example, the Project ID # for the #1 priority project in Niagara County would be 30-1. Please include the Project ID# on the top of the first page of each copy of the proposal.
