Summary of Department and Authority Policy regarding State Finance Law Sections §139-j and §139-k.

Pursuant to State Finance Law Sections §139-j and §139-k, this solicitation includes and imposes certain restrictions on communications between the Department of Agriculture and Markets, ("Fair") and the Industrial Exhibit Authority, ("Authority") and a vendor/contractor during the procurement process. Certain findings of non-responsibility can result in rejection for contract award and in the event of two such findings within a four year period, the vendor/contractor is debarred from obtaining governmental procurement contracts.
