- 1. What happened with the RFP for parking management services?
 - a. The Department declined to make an award from Request for Proposal "SF00206 State Fair Parking Management Services" as permitted on page 13 of the RFP.
- 2. Is there any mandatory walkthrough for this Request for Quotes?
 - a. No, there is no mandatory walkthrough for the Quote.
- 3. Upon the recommendation by the selected operator for staffing needs, the state fair will hire and pay directly the employees for the parking operation, correct?
 - a. Correct
- 4. The parking staff will be fair employees and not employees of the selected operator, correct?
 - a. Correct
- 5. If the employees are employed by the fair, workers compensation would no longer apply to the selected operator, correct?
 - a. The selected operator will need to contact the NYS Workers' Compensation Board to determine if the management team requires coverage.

- 6. If the employees are fair employees, does the operator still need to offer uniforms?
 - a. No
- 7. All of the equipment that is to be used by the operator -office trailer, gators, trucks, etc., will be provided by the state fair and will not be charged to the operator, correct?
 - a. The Department will provide the equipment listed in the fact sheet and not charge the operator. The use of the gators and trucks will be restricted to employees of the Department. If the operator requires any equipment that is not listed, including vehicles for use by management personnel, that will be at the operator's expense.
- 8. Is the selected operator to offer their specific position and staffing recommendation to the fair, or are we to use the existing position and staffing schedules as shown?
 - a. The operator may offer its specific position and staffing recommendations for the Department's review and approval.
- 9. Who pays for the adverting to get staff?

- 10. Who cleans up the equipment, signs and other equipment after the event?
