Printing of FMNP Support Materials

- 1) **Q. Do we need a NYS Vendor ID number to send in a bid?**
A. No. Bids may be submitted without a NYS Vendor ID.

- 2) **Q. I am planning to broker this bid out to one of my printers. Can I still submit the Invitation for bids?**
A. Bids will be considered only from bonafide printing companies possessing printing equipment capable of producing the printing requirements described in this invitation for bids.

- 3) **Q. I have a question about bonafide Printers. My company has signed contracts with different printing plants to produce product for them. If I list the companies' name that produces the product with my company will this qualify?**
A. A bonafide printing companies is one that possesses printing equipment capable of producing our printing requirements.

- 4) **Q. Would it be possible to see samples of previous pocket folders/ items use in 2011 for this program?**
A. See attached samples.

- 5) **Q. Farmers' Marker Schedules – is there any specific packaging requirements such as banding or wrapping or just bulk pack in cartons?**
A. Bulk pack in cartons is acceptable.

- 6) **Q. Where do the Pocket folders and Farmers' Market Schedules get delivered? Your local Albany office or another location?**
A. 10b Airline Drive, Albany, NY 12235

- 7) **Q. Under Program Pocket Folders (Attachment 1.1, page 11) in the "QUANTITY" section, the specs says there are 4 lots but only show quantities for 3 lots.**
A. There are only 3 lots to be printed

- 8) **Q. In the "CONSTRUCTION" section, they mention an English/Russian bilingual version that is not mentioned in the "QUANTITY" section.**
A. We have sufficient quantities of our Russian/English folder so we will not be printing them this year even though they are included in the general information section of the narrative.

- 9) **Q. REQUEST FOR BID (Attachment 2), the quantity indicated for the English/Spanish Pocket Folders is 372,000. This does not match the 375,000 quantity in Attachment 1.1.**
A. Use the \$375,000 quantity referenced in attachment 1.1
