General Grant Writing Considerations

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Practical Tips

- Read the RFP closely, address every aspect, and follow the guidelines.
- Understand what is most important to the granting agency.
- Reviewers may not have your level of expertise in the subject. Write accordingly.
- Address high priority issues and develop a compelling case.



Common Proposal Criticisms

- Insufficient justification
 - Not addressing a high priority need
 - Already been done / being done
- Another project already funded
- Unlikely to have an impact
- Vague, unfocused, confusing
- Lack of capacity to conduct project
- Question completion within timeframe
- Poor budget justification



Being responsible/accountable for the actual adoption of practices and the resulting farm level impacts.


