### Questions and Answers and Additional Information for Clarification

\*Please note that the questions that follow are taken directly from the emails received by the Department.

1. Section 2.2 Definitions (page 5) – Acceptable items are defined by OCRRA. <a href="https://ocrra.org/resource-pages/resource-page-category/ley-creek-drop-off-site#acceptable">https://ocrra.org/resource-pages/resource-page-category/ley-creek-drop-off-site#acceptable</a>

The Department is aware of this. As noted on the website referenced above, the list of material listed is not all-inclusive.

2. Section 2.3.2, Work Specifications

\*Section A (page 7) - Should state 8yd Front load compactor vertical style.

Section 2.3.2 A. 1 (b) first bullet should read: "8 cubic yard stationary compactor, front load vertical style or similar."

\*Section B – Fairtime – additional items should be added. (1) Closed recycle Roll-Off Containers (2) Receiver box for customer owned compactor.

No additional items should be added. Please provide pricing for the types and sizes of trash receptacles listed on the Bid Form. The following shall be added to the definition of "Open Top Roll-Off Container" in Section 2.2, page 6, of the IFB: "If requested by the Department, all roll-off containers shall be equipped with a tight fitting screened or solid cover operated by a functional winch system that is maintained in good repair."

3. Section G – Payment for Services

We request that the time allowed to submit invoice copies and tickets be changed to "the tenth day of the month". This will allow sufficient time for compiling the invoices, tickets and mailing the package.

No later than the tenth (10th) day of the month is acceptable.

We are unable to extract the disposal charges related to the New York State Fairgrounds from the monthly invoice provided to us by OCRRA. We do not receive a separate invoice related to the services provided to the New York State Fairgrounds. Please confirm it is acceptable for us to provide confirmation that disposal is a pass-through by the other provisions in the contract. This is to include our contract with OCRRA that lists the actual disposal rates charged and the tickets included with the invoice.

#### This is acceptable.

4. Exhibit 1 – Please confirm the number of Toter Lifts that will be required. Historically, three (3) have been provided. The bid lists 13.

In 2014 and 2015, three (3) toter lifts were provided. Exhibit 1 "Summary of Trash Removal and Disposal Services Rendered at the NYS Fairgrounds 2014-2015," and Exhibit 2 "Rating Form" have been modified accordingly (please see REVISED Exhibit 1 and REVISED Exhibit 2 attached).

\*Items should be added/modified in Exhibit 1 and Attachment 1.

No changes to Attachment 1 "Bid Form" are necessary. Exhibit 1 "Summary of Trash Removal and Disposal Services Rendered at the NYS Fairgrounds 2014-2015" was modified as set forth above.

#### **Additional Information for Clarification:**

- For the 2015 NYS Fair, only one (1) twenty (20) cubic yard open top roll-off container was enclosed.
- During the 2014 and 2015 NYS Fairs, the Fair rented thirteen (13) thirty-five (35) cubic yard self-contained compactors, which includes the four (4) Year-Round thirty-five cubic yard self-contained compactors.
- The four (4) Year-Round thirty-five (35) cubic yard self-contained compactors did NOT have cart tippers.
- One (1) stationary compactor is located behind the Maintenance building on the NYS Fairgrounds.
- On very rare occasions the Fair has experienced that recycling material was contaminated with trash. When this has occurred in the past the Department was charged the trash rate from OCRRA.
